

## GP services provided at Charlestown Medical Centre and fees

- Standard consultation: €50
- Review consultation: €30 (same medical problem reviewed within 2 weeks and/or returning for blood test results)
- Family consultation (2 members): €80
- Family consultation (3 members): €100
- Repeated prescription: €25
- Medical certificate (without consultation): €25
- Letter (without consultation): €25
- Driving licence medical: €50 (private & GMS patients)
- Contraceptive pill check & prescription: €35
- Pre-employment medical: €80 (private & GMS patients)
- Medico-legal report: €300
- Medico-legal report (updated): €200
- Well man check: €150 (~30 mins. consultation & one follow-up consultation with the results; includes detailed medical history & physical exam, urinalysis, prostate check, peak flow (respiratory test); any other tests/referrals or follow-ups will cost extra)
- Well woman check: €150 (~30mins. consultation & one follow-up consultation with the results; includes detailed medical history & physical exam, urinalysis, breast check, peak flow (respiratory test); any other tests/referrals or follow-ups will cost extra)
- Helicobacter Pylori quick test (results available in 15 minutes): €15 (in addition to the consultation fee)
- Streptococcal Group A quick test (results available in 15 minutes): €15 (in addition to the consultation fee)
- Travel vaccination: €80 (excludes cost of vaccines)
- Sutures & staples removal: €50
- Flu vaccine administration (over 65 years and/or qualifying condition): €25 (free for GMS patients)
- Flu vaccine administration (under 65 years and/or no qualifying conditions): €35 (private & GMS)
- Antenatal & postnatal care: €50 (first visit only, then free of charge under the Maternity and Infant Scheme)
- Sexual health screen (STI screening): €100 (includes consultation, blood tests and swabs)
- Mirena coil insertion (excludes prescription cost): €180, this includes: 1.Pre-insertion consultation +/- swabs (30 mins. appointment, €80); 2.Insertion of coil (30 mins. appointment, €100); 3.Free post-insertion check at 6 weeks
- Mirena coil removal: €60
- Implanon insertion (excludes prescription cost): €120, this includes: 1.Pre-insertion counselling (20 mins. appointment, €60); 2.Insertion of device (20 mins. appointment, €60)
- Implanon removal: €80 (30 mins. appointment)
- Smear test: €90 (free if eligible for CervicalCheck screening programme)
- Minor surgical procedures: €175 - €250 (depending on complexity of work required)
- Wart removal (cryotherapy): €80 (consists of initial treatment & follow-ups until complete resolution)
- Depo-provera® injection: €50 (prescription, blood pressure check & administration of injection, excludes cost of medicine)

## Practice Nurse services provided at Charlestown Medical Centre and fees

- Blood test adults: €20
- Blood test (children 4 - 14yrs): €25
- Childhood immunisation: free (under Primary Childhood Immunisation Scheme)
- Anti-tetanus vaccination: €25 (incl. cost of vaccine)
- Other injectable treatments: €20 (per session)
- Dressing clinic (new wound): €50\* (if no suture is required)
- Dressing clinic (follow-up): €20 (per session)\*
- Travel vaccination: €20 (per each vaccine, excludes cost of vaccines)
- Flu vaccination (>65yrs and/or qualifying conditions): €25 (free for GMS patients)
- Flu vaccination (<65yrs and/or no qualifying conditions): €35 (private & GMS)
- Breast feeding support: €20 (per session)

(\*) includes cost of materials, work & diet advice for optimal wound healing

### From November 2013 (by appointment only):

- Sutures (stitches) & staples removal: €40
- Bereavement support: €50 (3 sessions)
- Inhaler technique: €20
- Insuline injection technique: €20
- Heparin ( eg. Innohep®) injection technique: €20
- Depo-provera® injection with the nurse: €35 (incl. blood pressure check; excludes cost of medicine)

- Ante-natal visits (midwife): €40 (free under the Maternity and Infant Scheme)
- Ante-natal & Post-natal classes: €150\*

(\*) consisting of 4 theoretical & practical sessions (90 mins. per session) during the weekends; very useful for young mothers (they will learn about "body changes during & immediately after pregnancy", "dos and don'ts during and after pregnancy", "breast & bottle feeding explained", "nappy changing & nappy-related conditions", and many other topics (future daddies are welcome together with their partners).
